The Commission has reviewed the request filed on April 15, 2020 by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company for a mandatory waiver of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") requirement for a project to rebuild a portion of an existing overhead transmission line in Harford County.
